- 4 (Murphy) The Navy SEALS took an off-the-shelf S&W Model 39, hung a suppressor on it and used it for up close mostly to silence guard dogs for which it became known as the M 22 hush \_\_\_\_
- 5 (Huon) The AMD 5.56 is a gas action with a piston, operation works like others automatic weapons fed by magazine
- 9 (Wicks/Tansella) The Self Loading Rifle L1A1, more commonly known simply as the SLR, was a long rifle and is technically a battlefield rifle as opposed to an \_\_\_\_ rifle
- 10 (Williams) British developments of a .600/.500 inch cartridge during the Great War originally was derived from an \_\_\_\_ gun round
- **12** (Burgreen) The TP9SA is a polymer framed \_\_\_\_ fired handgun that distinctly resembles the Walther P99
- 13 (Madurski) The PTRD 1941, 14.5mm protivotankovoe ruzhe sistemy Degtyareva, obr. 1941, is a single shot rifle that, with the exception of the pistol grip, the cheek and butt pads, is made entirely of \_\_\_\_
- 15 (Brudenell) The Tandem Kross "Kanewolf" slingshot kit replaces the locking ball and detent bolt stop/release with a shorter spring-loaded bolt stop that will automatically disengage when the bolt is \_\_\_\_ in the absence of an empty magazine
- 17 (Small) The "Trapdoor rifle" or "\_\_\_ Conversion" was the modification of rifle-muskets converted to breech-loading rifles by cutting into the breech and adapting a hinged "trapdoor" breechblock mechanism
- 18 Patriot Ordnance Factory (abbr)
- 20 (Meehl) The sub-compact RM 380 chambered in the titular .380ACP. is an all metal hammer fired \_\_\_\_-pistol
- 22 Joint Services Combat Shotgun (abbr)
- 24 (Vining) The compact Soviet AKS74U, the "\_\_\_" or "Krinkov", is called "Suchka" by the Soviet soldiers, which translates to "Little Bitch"
- 25 Infantry automatic Rifle (abbr)
- 26 (Choat) The MAC 1911 Bobcut was named this primarily because of the \_\_\_ grip of the pistol

- 1 (Segel) In the early years of firearms development, when matchlock and flintlock rifles afforded single shots and a slow reloading time, \_\_\_ were affixed to the rifles and served the purpose of todays bayonet
- 2 Location of Miss and Hit (abbr)
- 3 (Bartocci) The M4 was the first shotgun Benelli had ever made that did not use the inertia operating system, instead it used a \_\_\_\_ operated mechanism
- 6 (Folloder) One of the most common \_\_\_\_ regarding the ownership of NFA items: "By registering, I'm giving the ATF and every other federal agent the ability to come inspect me at any time"
- 7 (Ficaretta/Reeves) ATF, charged with jurisdiction over permanent imports under the Arms Export Control Act, requires an import permit for "forgings, castings, and \_\_\_\_ bodies
- 8 (Lake) The Kel-Tec SUB-2000 is a blowback operated pistol caliber carbine that feeds from commonly available pistol magazines; it is a recreational \_\_\_\_ arm while the SU2000-SS is a professional grade, 9mm only
- 11 High Explosive Dual Purpose (abbr)
- 14 (Lazarides/Montgomery) The Tank Abwehr Gewehr Mod 18, or T-Gewehr, was the world's first anti-tank rifle and was developed by \_\_\_\_
- 16 (Volk) The Polish P64 is a simple blowback pistol that features a \_\_\_\_ safety
- 19 (Evancoe) Lockup is often interchanged with "locked breech" and "in battery"; but the basis for the in-battery definition used today in the world of firearms means the recoiling mass of the weapon—e.g., bolt, slide, carrier and so on—is in the proper \_\_\_\_ position
- 21 (Kontis) The starting point in the design of any Gatling is the elliptical in the main housing
- 23 (lannamico) The M.P. 18,I machine pistol was affectionately nicknamed the Kugelspritze or bullet \_\_\_\_ by the German troops
- 24 (lannamico) The first semi-automatic pistol chambered for the .30
